

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.



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1. Out of Bounds

Out of bounds is defined by the course-side edge at ground level of fence posts, white stakes and/or lines.

If both white stakes and lines are present, the line defines the edge and stakes are for identification.

Note: The stakes or posts themselves are out of bounds.

Internal Out of Bounds:

During play of Hole 4, the left side of the hole, defined by white stakes, is out of bounds.

These stakes are boundary objects during the play of Hole 4. For all other holes, they are movable obstructions.

2. Ball Lost or Out of Bounds – General Play Only

When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance.

For two penalty strokes, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or another ball in this relief area (see Rule 14.3):

Ball Reference Point:

The estimated point where the original ball either:

- Came to rest on the course, or
- Last crossed the course boundary.

Fairway Reference Point:

The nearest fairway point (on the same hole) that is not nearer the hole than the Ball Reference Point.

Relief area must:

- Be in the general area
- Not be nearer the hole than the Ball Reference Point

This relief option may not be used if:

- The ball is known or virtually certain to be in a penalty area, or
- The player has played a provisional ball (Rule 18.3).

3. Penalty Areas

Penalty areas are defined by red or yellow stakes and/or lines.

If both are present, the line defines the edge; stakes are for identification.

If the ball is in a penalty area (or virtually certain to be), the player may take one of the following relief options for one penalty stroke:

1. Stroke-and-Distance Relief (Rule 14.6)
2. Back-On-the-Line Relief (Rule 14.3)
3. Lateral Relief (only for red penalty areas) – drop within two club-lengths from where the ball last crossed the edge (Rule 14.3)

Drop Zones – General Play Only

Where a dropping zone is provided, it may be used as an extra relief option for a ball in a penalty area under the Rules of Golf. Dropping zones are marked with short white and blue stakes and a sign labeled "Drop Zone." When using a dropping zone, the ball must be dropped within the marked area and come to rest within the zone.

4. Abnormal Course Conditions

The edging grooves around the aprons or fringes of putting greens are ground under repair.

Distance markers, young trees with supports, cart paths, concrete drains (with or without grates), permanent signs, staircases, internal/protective fences, electrical boxes, buildings, sprinkler heads, valve covers, sump covers, and halfway houses are Immovable Obstructions.

Free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.
